3.	Connects patient to defibrillator correctly
Demonstrates	Charges pads during compressions
safe	Utilises the COACHED communication tool to ensure safety
defibrillation	Analyses rhythms correctly and identifies shockable or non-shockable side of
technique	the algorithm
C.O.A.C.H.E.D	Has situational awareness to ensure the team is safe when delivering the shock
	Delivers the shock with minimal pause to compressions
	Safely disarms defibrillator if non-shockable rhythm present
	Ensures that CPR immediately commences after defibrillation/disarming
4. Follows ALS algorithm	Correctly identifies the rhythm and selects the appropriate side of the ALS algorithm
	• Initiates appropriate treatment (e.g. defibrillation, IV/IO cannulation, advanced airway management)
	Orders correct drugs, doses, and administration intervals
	Assesses reversible causes
